§92.34 Right of Entry and Inspection.

Upon reasonable cause, the Fire Chief, Police Officers or any authorized Building Commissioner of the City of Seymour who presents credentials may inspect any property for the purpose of ascertaining compliance with the provisions of this subchapter.

§92.35 Enforcement.

The Fire Chief, the Building Commissioner or their designees, and the Police Department are authorized to enforce the provisions of this subchapter.

FIREWORKS

§92.45 Use, Discharge or Ignition Prohibited

(A) The use, discharge or ignition of consumer fireworks by any person or other entity is prohibited in the corporate limits of the City of Seymour except during the following periods:

1. Between the hours of 5:00 P.M. and two (2) hours after sunset on June 29, June 30, July 1, July 2, July 3, July 5, July 6, July 7, July 8 and July 9 each year, and
2. Between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 12:00 midnight on July 4 each year, and
3. Between the hours of 10:00 A.M. on December 31 until 1:00 A.M. the next day each year.

(B) *Consumer fireworks* shall have the meaning as set forth in Indiana Code 22-11-14-1 as may be amended from time to time.

(C) The use, discharge or ignition of all other fireworks shall be governed by Indiana state statutes.

§92.99 Penalties for Violation

Violations of this chapter shall be subject to the penalty provisions of §10.99 of this code.
